

LBWID Board of Trustees Vacancy

Jerry Mendenhall, one of the three Trustees of the Lake Barcroft Watershed Improvement District (WID), will be resigning his position after 13 years of impeccable service to the community. To assist in choosing his successor, the WID and the LBA Board have formed a joint Nominating Committee composed of the two continuing Trustees, Alan Pisarski (Chair) and George McLennan, and two members of the LBA Board, Michael Montfort, and Larry Hoffer. Expressions of interest in being nominated to fill this vacancy for trustee and/or suggestions of qualified candidates are sought from all members of the community.

A governmental body with taxing power, the WID is responsible for maintaining and operating the Lake Barcroft Dam and maintaining the quality of the Lake. It functions with an annual operating and capital budget of approximately \$1,350,000, a full-time paid staff, and several external support contractors and consultants,

In brief, Trustees serve a 5-year term. While only one Trustee is stepping down nominees should consider themselves candidates for any of the three positions: Chairman, Treasurer or Secretary/Operations Advisor. Also know that by the time you see this announcement one or more potential candidates are likely to have been approached by the nominating committee to gauge their interest in filling the position.
