

LBWID Board of Trustees Vacancy

Alan Pisarski, one of the three Trustees of the Lake Barcroft Watershed Improvement District (LBWID), will be resigning his position after 10 years of impeccable service to the community. To assist in choosing his successor, the LBWID and the LBA Board have formed a joint Nominating Committee composed of the two continuing Trustees, Brenda Pierce (Chair) and Jim Simonson (Treasurer), and two members of the LBA Board. Expressions of interest in being nominated to fill this vacancy for Trustee and/or suggestions of qualified candidates are sought from all members of the community.

The LBWID is a governmental body with taxing power and is responsible for maintaining and operating the Lake Barcroft Dam and maintaining the environmental quality of the Lake. The LBWID functions with an annual operating and capital budget of approximately \$1,700,000, a full-time paid staff, and several external support contractors and consultants. LBWID Trustees are responsible for overseeing the governance, strategic direction, financial health, and legal and ethical compliance of the LBWID, and ensuring that it operates in the best interests of its taxpayers. LBWID Trustees serve a 5-year term, often serving two terms.
